Scam Alert!!!

- Residents should not respond to requests for personal information over the telephone.
- The IRS will not request information from you through a telephone call. The police are NOT waiting down the block to arrest you if you do not respond to the caller's demands.
- Your grandchild is most likely not in jail and money orders need not be obtained to secure their release.
- Another recent scam we saw was recruiting an unwitting resident to be a secret shopper and rate a stores service. They mailed out postal money orders and asked you to deposit them in your bank account and then utilize your banking information to make purchases. The money orders were fairly good forgeries and were worthless.
- Trust your instincts and follow up with your financial institutions to verify any requests for information.

Although we have found that most of these thieves are from out of the country and beyond our reach you are encouraged to contact the Wonder Lake Police Department if you have information regarding a scam at (815) 728-0535 .

A Few Important Reminders:

- The Village garage sale dates have been set as follows: May 17, 18 & 19 and August 2, 3 & 4. If you choose to have a garage sale on days other than listed above, please contact the Village to obtain your permit.
- Please remember that the water service line from the water main to your building is the responsibility of the owner/renter according to the Village Ordinance #350. If you suspect a leak on the service line, contact the Village Hall at (815) 728-0839 or the water department at 1-866-371-5699 to verify a problem. *Leaks need immediate attention and sometimes go unnoticed for months.*
- Water bills can be paid online. Visit our website at <http://villageofwonderlake.org> to make your water/sewer payment in the form of: Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover. You may still choose to pay your bill online, by mail, or by dropping it at the Village Hall.
- No parking on the grass or on easements
- Limit of two trailers per residence
- The combined Village and County ordinances impose the following restrictions on open burning of yard waste: Burning of landscape waste is prohibited within 100 feet of a habitable structure or within 50 feet of a structure that is not habitable. (garage, shed, barn, swimming pool, etc.); • Only on Saturdays between dawn and dusk in October and November, then again in April and May; • All open burning must be supervised by an individual at least 18 years of age until the fire is extinguished and a fire extinguisher or garden hose or water source must be available at the burning site; • Landscape waste is defined as grass clippings, shrubbery, cuttings, leaves, flowers and weeds. Recreational fires, for warmth or cooking are allowed any day of the year with several restrictions: • The fire shall be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet by 3 feet; • Shall be brush only (no leaves, grass, shrubbery clippings, weeds or furniture); • Brush is defined as tree trunks, limbs, branches and twigs.
