**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE
OF WONDER LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE BY
ADDING A CHAPTER 74 NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLES
TO TITLE 7 OF THE TRAFFIC CODE**

2. Approval. If the Village of Wonder Lake Board of Trustees approves the application to operate non-highway vehicles in the subdivision, all of the provisions set forth in paragraphs 74.03, 74.04, 74.05, 74.06 and 74.07 shall be applicable to such approval. Such approval is only for streets within the subdivision.
3. Revocation. The Village Board of Trustees reserves the right to revoke such approval of a subdivision to operate non-highway vehicles on the subdivision's streets due to violations of this Ordinance or to eliminate the entire program of non-highway vehicles if they determine such program should be eliminated.

74.03 Operation Regulations. Where authorized, the operation of a non-highway vehicle is subject to the following:

1. A non-highway vehicle shall be subject to inspection by the Police Department prior to being operated on any of the permitted streets. A fee of \$50.00 shall be assessed for the initial application/inspection of each non-highway vehicle followed by an annual re-inspection fee of \$10.00 for the same vehicle each year thereafter.
2. A non-highway vehicle may only be operated on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less.
3. A non-highway vehicle may cross a designated street at an intersection where the street has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour.
4. A person may not operate a non-highway vehicle upon any street in the Village of Wonder Lake unless he or she has a valid driver's license issued in his or her name by the Secretary of State or by a foreign jurisdiction.

5. The operator shall yield the right of way to all pedestrian and vehicular traffic which constitutes a hazard.
6. The operation of the non-highway vehicle shall be in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code (Act 5, Chapter 62 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, as amended).

74.04 Vehicle Equipment. No non-highway vehicle may be operated on a roadway unless, at a minimum, it has the following: brakes, a steering apparatus, tires, a rearview mirror, red reflectorized warning devices in the front and rear, a slow moving emblem (as required of other vehicles in 625 ILCS 5/12-709) on the rear of the non-highway vehicle, a headlight that emits a white light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front, a tail lamp that emits a red light visible from at least 100 feet from the rear, brake lights and turn signals. When operated on a roadway, a non-highway vehicle shall have its headlight and tail lamps lighted as required by 625 ILCS 5/12-201.

74.05 Driving under the Influence. A person who drives or is in actual physical control of a non-highway vehicle while under the influence shall be subject to 625 ILCS 5/11-500 through 5/11-502.

74.06 Insurance. Any person who operates a non-highway vehicle in the Village of Wonder Lake shall be subject to the mandatory insurance requirements in 625 ILCS 5/7-601 et seq.

74.07 Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Section shall be fined not more than a Class C Misdemeanor and be responsible for the Village of Wonder Lake's cost of prosecution, including reasonable attorney's fees.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment

shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
